This term in Robin Class, we will be exploring the central idea that *sharing ideas and beliefs helps us understand each other*. We will be becoming artists as we inquire into how people share their ideas and beliefs through artistic expression. The children will experiment with different materials, techniques, and styles to communicate their own thoughts and feelings creatively.

We will also be thinking about how we can understand and empathise with others through the ideas and beliefs they express, and how our own artistic creations can inspire or impact those who experience them. Through this unit, the children will develop their creativity, appreciation for different perspectives, and confidence in expressing themselves as true artists.

Alongside this, we will continue to extend our phonics learning as the children become more independent in their reading and writing. They will have many opportunities to apply their growing phonics knowledge to explore new vocabulary, express their ideas in writing, and enjoy a wide range of stories and texts that connect to our central theme.

In mathematics, we will continue working with numbers up to five, with a big focus on subitising — recognising small quantities without counting. Through play, hands-on activities, and problem-solving, the children will strengthen their number sense and build a strong foundation for future mathematical learning.
